

E.S.P. Dress Code

The following is a list of the proper attire to be worn in each class. Hair should always be pulled back and no loose jewelry should be worn. There should never be baggy clothes or jeans in any class except Tap and Hip Hop.

Creative Any color Leotard and Tights, or other dance attire
Shoes: Tan buckle Tap shoes, and Pink Ballet Shoes

Tap Any clothes you can move in as long as your ankles are showing.
Shoes: Recreational classes age 12 and Under – Tan Buckle Tap Shoes
Pre-Professional & Teen Recreational – Black Tap Shoes

Jazz Any color leotard or tight fitting top with Jazz pants or booty shorts
Shoes: Black Jazz slip-on or foot paw/undies

Ballet
Recreational Ballet – Any color Leotard and Tights
Pre-Professional Ballet – Black Leotard, Pink Tights – Hair in a Bun.
Shoes: Pink Ballet

Lyrical Any color leotard or tight fitting top with Jazz pants or booty shorts
Shoes: Foot Paws or Foot Undies

Hip Hop Any clothes you can move in.
Shoes: Sneakers

Modern Any color leotard or tight fitting top with Jazz pants or booty shorts
Shoes: No shoes are worn in modern.

Acro Fitted clothing or Leotard.
Shoes: No shoes are worn in Acro.

Male Dancers Any clothes you can move in. Solid color fitted t-shirt, sweat shorts, gym shorts.
Shoes: Same as girls for each discipline except Black Ballet Shoes and Black Tap Shoes
